Subject	Safety of civil aircraft operating in Cairo FIR

Applicability	All Singapore Air Operator Certificate (AOC) Holders
Description	<p>Note: This SIB is revised to update the reference publication to EASA CZIB-2017-09R8 issued on 29 April 2022.</p> <p>EASA CZIB 2017-09R8 has been issued to extend the validity of the CZIB to 31 Jul 2022 and to amend reference publications in view of ongoing extremist/militant activities involving anti-aircraft weapons, including man-portable air defence systems (MANPADS), anti—tank missiles and small-arms fire. Operators are strongly advised to avoid operating lower than FL250 in this airspace.</p> <p>CAAS draws all Singapore AOC holders’ attention to the possible existence of serious risks to the safety of international civil flights operating into Cairo (HECC) FIR.</p>
Recommendation(s)	<p>Assess flight safety risk for flights over Cairo (HECC) FIR.</p> <p>Singapore AOC holders are strongly urged to use this, and any other pertinent information, to assess flight safety risk for flights over Cairo FIR. Singapore AOC holders are also encouraged to contact their respective Principal Operations Inspectors (POIs) to share any additional information regarding the threat and risk to safety and security of civil aviation.</p>
