Subject	Safety of civil aircraft operating in Somalia (Mogadishu FIR – HCSM) airspace
Ref. Publications	1) EASA CZIB No.: 2017-05R9 2) FAA KICZ NOTAM A0028/19
Purpose	This SIB is revised to update reference publication EASA CZIB 2017-05R9.
Applicability	All Singapore Air Operator Certificate (AOC) Holders
Cancellation	This SIB supersedes the previous SIB dated 12 October 2017 on this subject.
Description	The security situation in Somalia remains unstable. The EASA extends the validity of the CZIB No. 2017-05R9 from 29 April 2022 to 31 October 2022 in view of the risk of operations and overflights below FL260 in Somalia due to the hazardous situation with the presence of terrorist organisations with confirmed anti-aviation weaponry, possibly MANPADS (man-portable air-defence systems) and ongoing military operations.
Recommendation(s)	Assess flight safety risk in Somalia FIR and at airports of Somalia. Singapore AOC holders are strongly urged to use this, and any other pertinent information, to assess flight safety risk in the Somalia (Mogadishu FIR – HCSM) airspace and at airports of Somalia. Singapore AOC holders are also encouraged to contact their respective Principal Operations Inspectors (POIs) to share any additional information regarding the threat and risk to safety and security of civil aviation.
