

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Amendment to Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 66 and Issuance of AC 66-13

Please be informed that the Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 66 (SAR-66) on *Aircraft Maintenance Licensing* has been amended to:

- Remove the minimum one-month application period for a licence renewal;
- Remove obsolete requirements related to SAR-7 in view of the completion of the conversion of SAR-7 to SAR-66 Aircraft Maintenance Licence (AML);
- Clarify the requirements for conversion of a foreign AML;
- Move information on SAR-66 basic examination syllabi and the examination modules to AC 66-13 on SAR-66 Basic Examinations;
- Clarify that an application after an AML has expired is not considered a renewal, but a re-issue of the expired AML.

AC 66-13 on SAR-66 Basic Examinations has been issued because of the amendments to SAR-66. The AC provides guidance and information related to the requirements on SAR-66 basic examinations.

The SAR-66 (Issue 2 Amendment 6) and AC 66-13 come into effect on 24 September 2021. They can be found at the [CAAS website](#).
