

<h1>NOTICE OF AMENDMENT</h1>

Amendments to Air Operations Air Navigation Regulations (Air Ops ANRs) and Air Navigation Order (ANO)

Please be informed that the following amendment regulations have come into effect on 4 November 2021:

- a. Air Navigation (91 - General Operating Rules) (Amendment No. 836) Regulations 2021;
- b. Air Navigation (121 – Commercial Air Transport by Large Aeroplanes) (Amendment No. 837) Regulations 2021;
- c. Air Navigation (135 – Commercial Air Transport by Helicopters and Small Aeroplanes) (Amendment No. 838) Regulations 2021; and
- d. Air Navigation (Amendment) Order 2021 (S839/2021).

The key amendments are in the following areas:

In item (a)	To implement ICAO’s new requirements pertaining to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• a new Global Reporting Format (GRF) which standardises the assessment and reporting of runway surface conditions by the pilot-in-command of an aircraft.• the making of a safe landing by an aeroplane with consideration to the runway surface conditions.
In items (b) and (c)	To require a “no smoking” placard to be displayed in each lavatory and at appropriate locations in the aeroplane. This complements the associated “no smoking” requirements in the Air Navigation Act and Airworthiness Notice C29.
in item (d)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To facilitate the use of electronic signatures and to remove the use of wet-ink signature;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To clarify that the Manual of Standards — Licensing of Air Traffic Control Personnel (MOS-PEL) is also applicable to every person who is undergoing on the job training to act as an air traffic controller;• To remove an obsolete administrative procedure that requires an air traffic controller licence to be signed in the presence of an authorised person;• To clarify that an air traffic controller licence may be granted or renewed for up to the periods similar to those for pilot licences; and• To make editorial amendments for alignment of terminologies and references etc.
