

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Issuance of Advisory Circulars relating to the Technical Agreement on Maintenance between CAAS and CAANZ

Please be informed that the following Advisory Circulars (ACs) have been issued pertaining to the Technical Agreement on Maintenance between the Civil Authority of Singapore (CAAS) and the Civil Aviation Authority of New Zealand (CAANZ):

- (a) AC 145-18 on Implementation procedures for the Technical Arrangement on Maintenance (TA-M) between CAAS and CAANZ

This AC provides guidance and information for a SAR-145 approved maintenance organisation located in Singapore intending to perform work under the TA-M.

- (b) Revision 9 to AC 145-3 on Acceptability of aircraft parts

This revision adds the CAANZ Form 1 issued by AMOs participating in the TA-M into the list of equivalent release documents for a part that may be used on Singapore registered aircraft.
