

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Amendments to the Air Navigation Order (S351/2015)

The Air Navigation Order (ANO) has been amended by the Air Navigation (Amendment) Order 2015 (S351/2015) which came into effect on 2 June 2015.

3 The key changes to the ANO are:

- a) Amendment to paragraph 20A – to provide for the pairing of pilots who are both above 60 years of age;
- b) Insertion of paragraph 50DB – to require a public postal operator to hold certain approvals prior to accepting dangerous goods in air mail;
- c) Insertion of Part XA – to require certain permits to be obtained prior to operating an unmanned aircraft in Singapore; and
- d) Amendment to paragraph 87A – to require a foreign operator to obtain an operations permit from the Chief Executive before conducting any aerial work in Singapore.

4 An advisory circular, AC UAS-1, regarding the permits required for operating unmanned aircraft in Singapore has also been issued.
