

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Amendment of Airworthiness Notices, Singapore Airworthiness Requirements, Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 66, and Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 145

Please be informed of amendments to the following.

- **Airworthiness Notices (AN)**

The following Airworthiness Notices are deleted as they have been superseded by requirements in the Air Navigation Regulations.

- C6 Carriage of Emergency Locator Transmitter (ELT)
- C30 Automatic direction finding equipment on turbine engine aeroplanes and helicopters
- C52 Ground Proximity Warning System (EGPWS)

Revision 25 of the Airworthiness Notices comes into effect on 5 October 2018.

- **Singapore Airworthiness Requirements (SAR)**

The SAR has been revised to align with latest amendments to ICAO Standards, and as a consequence to the introduction of various Air Navigation Regulations and the repeal of Air Operator Certification Requirements. The key changes include:

- Insertion of a definition for “State of Manufacture”;
- Updates to references to respective Air Navigation Act and Air Navigation Regulations;
- Deletion of provisions (such as those regarding Permit to Fly, Fire Extinguishing Agents, Flight Recorders, and Extended Diversion Time Operations) that have been transferred to the Air Navigation Regulations, Aviation Specifications or Advisory Circulars;
- Transfer of reporting requirements to design organisation from Air Operator Certification Requirements (that has been repealed).

Revision 28 to Issue 2 of the SAR will come into effect on 5 October 2018.

- **Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 66 (SAR-66)**

The SAR-66 has been revised as a consequence to introduction of the various Air Navigation Regulations and the repeal of Air Operator Certification Requirements.

Amendment 5 of Issue 2 of the SAR-66 will come into effect on 5 October 2018.

- **Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 145 (SAR-145)**

The SAR-145 has been revised as a consequence to the repeal of Air Operator Certification Requirements.

Amendment 15 of Issue 1 of the SAR-145 will come into effect on 5 October 2018.
