

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Amendments to Air Navigation (101- Unmanned Aircraft Operations) Regulations 2019 relating to UA light shows in Singapore

Please be informed that the Air Navigation (101 – Unmanned Aircraft Operations) (Amendment) Regulations 2024 has been published in the Government Gazette on 5 July 2024.

The amendments removed the need for an UA light show operator to register each UA involved in the light show and also revised the initial application fee of a Class 1 Activity Permit for UA light shows to be S\$500 and the subsequent application fee of Class 1 Activity Permit for UA light shows at the same location with the same UA type to be S\$425, regardless of the number of UA flown.

The Regulations came into effect on 6 July 2024, and can also be found at our <u>CAAS</u> website.
